Rodrigo Gomez is a sixth-generation circus artist whose life has been shaped by the world of live performance from the very beginning. Born into an Argentine circus family while performing in Brazil, he grew up traveling internationally, learning his craft through generations of performers dedicated to preserving and evolving the circus arts.

He first stepped into the ring at just four years old as a clown alongside his father. By the age of eleven, he had begun training in aerial straps and made his professional debut in the discipline at twelve with Circus Royale in Australia. Throughout his career, Rodrigo has continued expanding his repertoire, eventually specializing in one of the circus world's most demanding disciplines: the Double Wheel.

His artistic journey has taken him across multiple continents, performing with renowned productions and companies in Australia, Japan, Argentina, Brazil, Germany, and the United States. Along the way, he has collaborated with internationally recognized directors and artists, continually refining his technical ability while embracing innovation and storytelling in contemporary circus.

Rodrigo has performed in major productions including **Siddharta, Buscando la Verdad**, directed by acclaimed Argentine producer Flavio Mendoza, before joining Cirque du Soleil. Since 2021, he has been a featured artist in **Drawn to Life**, the groundbreaking collaboration between Cirque du Soleil and Walt Disney Animation Studios at Disney Springs in Orlando, Florida. As a performer in the production's signature Double Wheel act, he combines exceptional athleticism, precision, and theatrical expression in one of the show's most visually captivating performances.

Beyond performing, Rodrigo is passionate about mentorship and artistic development. Throughout his career he has helped coach fellow artists, refine performance techniques, and contribute creatively to the evolution of high-level circus acts, demonstrating a commitment not only to excellence on stage but also to the continued growth of the circus community.

With decades of experience, a lifetime dedicated to performance, and a deep respect for his family's artistic legacy, Rodrigo Gomez represents a new generation of circus artists—combining traditional circus values with contemporary creativity, technical innovation, and world-class performance.
